Family circumstances

Hilalio is

the 3rd born child in a family of 5 children. He was brought up in Salima in the central region of Malawi by a single mother after his parents divorced. His mother sells madasi (doughnuts) earning a modest salary. **Hilalio** is the first in his family to attend university.

Education

Hilalio attended a community day secondary school in Malawi and achieved **11 points** in his Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE). Student points are calculated by adding the 6 highest subject points together. The better you do, the lower the score; 1-2 points = distinction; 3-4 points = credit; 5-6 points = pass. **Hilalio** did extremely well to achieve **11 points!** Unfortunately, he faced many challenges in his education, including missing classes due to unpaid fees.

There are just 49 registered dentists in Malawi. In the UK there are a total of 46,000.
